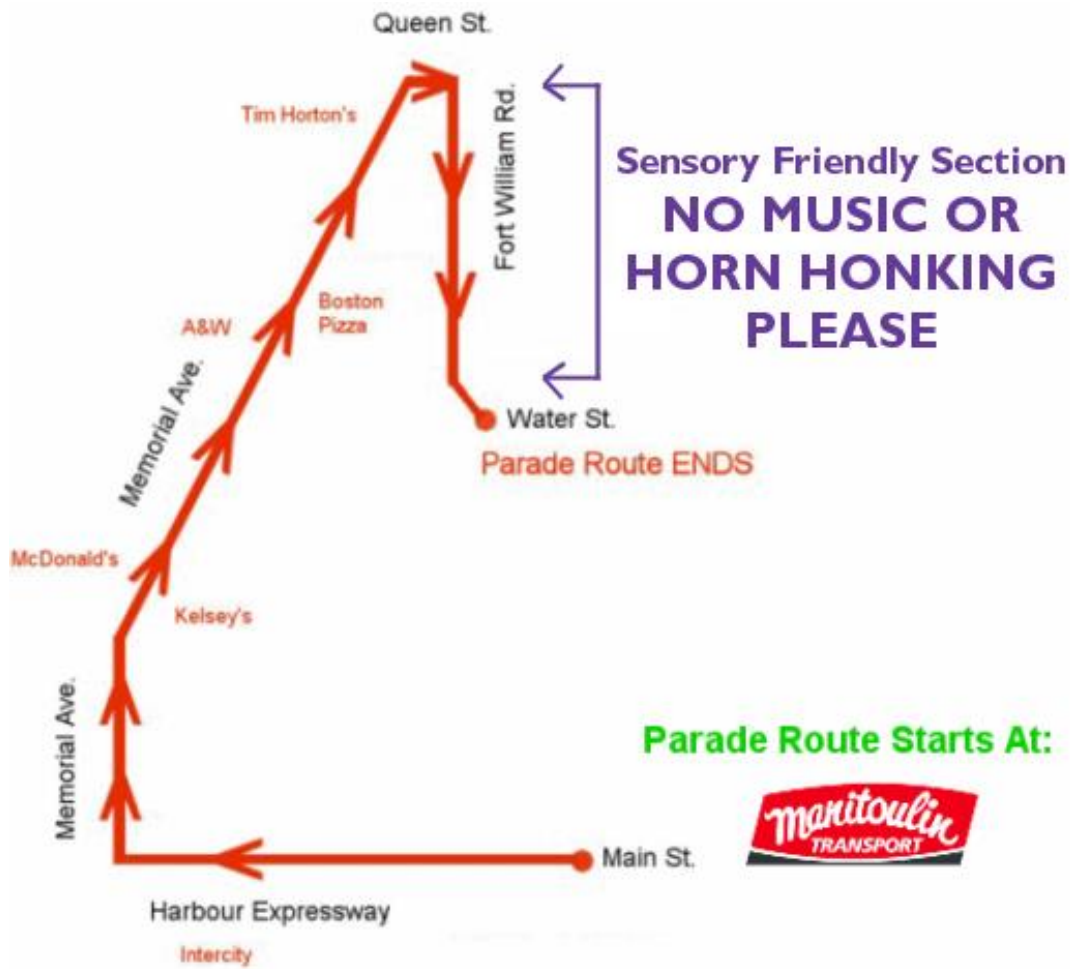

Parade of Lights Route: Parade route starts at Main Street to Harbour Expressway, Right onto Memorial Ave to Queen Street, parade route ends. Turn right onto Queen Street and you will be mainstreamed into regular traffic on Water St.





2020 RULES | PARTICIPANT INFORMATION | PLEASE READ

1. NO candy or treats are to be thrown from my vehicle.
2. If I have participants riding on my vehicle that they are loaded in a secondary location because parking is not allowed at Manitoulin Transport.
3. There are to be no walking participants with my vehicle.
4. There is no entry fee but I am to encourage my business or employees to make a donation on the gofundme page: www.gofundme.com or collect donations with the Donation Sheet that can be downloaded from our website.
5. Again this year there will be a **sensory friendly area** near the end of the parade once you turn the corner onto Fort William Rd to Water Street. All music & horn honking is asked to be stopped from that point forward. Lights stay on.
6. My vehicle must be at Manitoulin Transport for line up by 5:00pm-6:00pm to ensure a prompt parade start.
7. If my business or organization has multiple vehicles participating it is my responsibility to communicate all of the new information information to all drivers.
8. Younger kids can be confused as to why we have more than one Santa. We ask you to pick a different theme as we have one truck committed to being Santa.
